Thornapple Kellogg School District made AYP, as did all of our schools with the exception of our Alternative Education program. We did not test the required 95% of our alternative students due to student attendance issues. Our plan is to develop procedures to ensure that at least 95% of our alternative education students are present to take the full test.

McFall's (grades K-1) accreditation is determined by the MEAP results of Lee Elementary serving second and third grade students. Lee Elementary (grades 2-3), Page Elementary (grades 4-5), Middle School (grades 6-8), and the High School (grades 9-12) accreditation is determined by their MEAP and/or MME results. TK high school, middle school, Page Elementary, and Lee Elementary continue to achieve adequate yearly progress (AYP) based on state requirements for student achievement, and have all received "A's" on the School Report Card (McFall does not receive a grade due to being a K-1 building). While we are pleased to have reached this important goal, we are continuously working to improve. We appreciate the continued support of parents, staff, and our community in this effort.
