

How to Help Your School Earn Money

CLIP & SAVE



Box Tops for Education: This is a great way to help the school without much effort. Clip the “Box Tops for Education” label off from many different products including General Mills cereals, Cottonelle, Betty Crocker, Yoplait and Pillsbury. We have friendly collection contests at each elementary school in October and February. The schools earn

Spartan UPC Codes: Clip the UPC code from Spartan brand products and your school will earn 2¢. We do not need the whole label, just the UPC code including the word “Spartan”. McFall and Page participate in this program.

Campbell Labels for Education: Clip the UPC code from participating Campbell products. Depending on the product we earn 1 or 5 points. We use the points to purchase items for the school. McFall and Page participate in this program. Visit www.LabelsForEducation.com for more information.



Tyson: Tyson Project A+ allows your school to earn 24¢ for each A+ Label you cut and give to your school. We need the whole label including the words “Tyson A+ 1 2 3 Support Your School!”. COLLECT & SAVE



My Coke Rewards: Enter your Coke Reward Points at www.MyCokeRewards.com and then donate them to McFall Elementary School. We use the points to purchase items for the school. McFall participates in this program.



Ink Cartridges: We recycle and earn money for used printer cartridges and cell phones. McFall, Lee and Page participate in this program.



Paper Gator: Recycle your newspapers, catalogs, magazines, phone books and other papers and help the elementary schools earn money at the same time. We **cannot** accept any type of cardboard (including cereal boxes, tack board, or non-corrugated cardboard), metal, plastic or trash. The Paper Gator recycling bin is located in the southeast corner of the east parking lot (behind the Learning Center) at McFall Elementary. We earn \$20 for every ton of paper waste collected. McFall, Lee and Page share the revenue equally.

SHOPPING



Pizza Hut Fundraiser Nights: Every third Wednesday of the month the TK PTO holds a fundraiser night at the Caledonia Pizza Hut. We earn 20% of your purchase whether you dine in or take out. McFall, Lee and Page share the revenue equally.



Subway Cards: Pick up a Subway card and load it up. Then go online to link your card to your school at www.schoolpax.org/sbw/mini/. Each time you use your Subway card, the school earns 2% of your purchase. Each elementary school has its own code. The codes are as follows: McFall Elementary M53G, Lee Elementary ZZ29, and Page Elementary XC6M.

Meijer Community Rewards: Sign up for a Meijer Community Rewards card and your school can earn up to 1% of your total purchases! The Meijer Credit Card earns your school 1% of your total purchases while the Meijer 1 Card which is not a credit card earns your school 0.5%. Be sure to select your school as your designated organization. You can sign up for your Meijer Community Rewards card at any Meijer store, online at www.meijer.com/rewards or check out your PTO's bulletin board for applications. You can select up to three organizations on your account and your contribution will be divided equally. Each elementary school has its own code. The codes are as follows: McFall Elementary 223804, Lee Elementary 186968, and Page Elementary 726688.



Harding's: If you shop at Harding's be sure to sign up for a Harding's eScrip Community Card. Present your card to the cashier every time you shop and your school could earn up to 4% of your purchases. Sign up for your Harding's card at any Harding's store, online at www.escrip.com/hardings.jsp, or contact one of your PTO members for more information.

Target: Target's program called Take Charge of Education helps schools earn money each time you use their REDcard: Target Visa Credit Card, Target Credit Card or Target Check Card. Target will donate up to 1% of the amount of each purchase you make with your REDcard to your school of choice. For more information visit your local Target store or go online at www.target.com/tcoe. Each elementary school has its own code. The codes are as follows: McFall Elementary 63424, Lee Elementary 63426 and Page Elementary 63428.
