

# Back on Track Expectations

## Schedule:

Class meets Monday thru Thursday, from 2:45 pm-4:45 pm

Back on Track I: September 26 through November 17

Back on Track II: January 3 through March 1

Back on Track III: March 19 through May 17

## Tardies/Absences:

No absences are allowed. After one absence, a student may lose credit for the class if he/she does not make up assignments by the last day of the session.

A tardy is given up to 10 minutes after class begins. Two (2) tardies = one (1) absence.

If a student is late by more than 10 minutes, that constitutes an absence.

## Rules/Discipline Policy:

Students are expected to follow all school and classroom rules. Failure to follow the rules will result in the following procedures:

1 <sup>st</sup> offense	Verbal warning
2 <sup>nd</sup> offense	Meet with teacher/phone call home
3 <sup>rd</sup> offense	Sent home/phone call home

- Being sent home will count toward a student's one (1) absence.
- Note: Students may be sent home at any step of the discipline procedure if they are uncooperative or disruptive to others.
- Due to the shortened schedule, students are expected to complete all assignments and to work cooperatively with teachers and other students.

Failure to abide by these rules may result in loss of credit. Students are responsible for their own transportation to and from Back on Track.
